- Many refugees face trauma and hardship, making trust-building and discipleship a slow process.

- Population of Arabic speakers: 90,000+
- · Christian believers make up less than 3% of this group.
- · There are only six Arabic-speaking Christian churches in the city.
- · Largest religions in the area:
 - 1. Catholicism
 - 2. Islam
 - 3. Eastern Orthodoxy
